1999

The revolutionary Nteletsa Programme extended telecom access to over 127 rural villages.

2016

BTC became the first and only telecommunications provider to list on the Botswana Stock Exchange (BSE), creating a unique opportunity for citizen ownership.

2017-2024:

A digital transformation journey began launching 4.5C, investing in cloud solutions, expanding data infrastructure, and opening the Sentlhaga Data Centre.

Each milestone is not just a company achievement, it's a step in empowering Batswana with tools to thrive in an increasingly digital world.
